



SPECIAL INSPECTION AGREEMENT FORM

*Prior to issuance of a permit **Parts I through IV** of this form shall be completed, signed, and submitted to the Building Official for review and approval. **Part I** shall be completed by the Owner or Owner's Authorized Agent. **Part II** shall be signed by applicable parties. **Part III** shall be completed by the registered design professional (RDP) in responsible charge or the RDP responsible for structural design. **Part IV** shall be completed by the General Contractor. **Part V** shall be completed by the Special Inspection Agency and submitted to the Building Official prior to final inspection or issuance of Certificate of Occupancy. Please note that failure to comply with special inspection requirements may lead to additional project expenses and project delays due to issuance of stop work orders, destructive inspections & testing, in-situ load testing, and possible redesign.*

PART II - SPECIAL INSPECTION AND TESTING AGREEMENT

*When special inspections are required by Chapter 17 of the California Building Code (CBC), the RDP in responsible charge and RDP responsible for structural design shall prepare an inspection program (Part III), which shall be submitted to the Building Official for approval prior to issuance of the building permit. The special inspector shall be employed by the owner or an authorized agent of the owner, **BUT NOT the contractor, or any other person responsible for the work.***

The special inspection firm(s) named above has(have) been authorized to perform the special inspection and testing services designated in this agreement, and in accordance with the CBC requirements, shall report all activities and results to the Building Official, and other parties as listed. It is understood that special inspections are required in addition to, and are not a substitute for, the normal inspections performed by the Building Inspector.

The undersigned hereby affirm, under penalty of law that the special inspection program is in accordance with the requirements of the CBC and the City of Dixon. The undersigned has used all reasonable diligence in completing this form and to the best of his/her knowledge, the information contained herein is true and complete. The undersigned hereby certifies under the penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of California that the foregoing is true and correct.

This plan has been developed with the understanding that the Building Official will:

- Review and approve the qualifications of the Special Inspection Agency who will be responsible for the special inspections required for the project.
- Monitor special inspection activities on the job site to assure that the Special Inspectors are qualified and are performing their duties as called for in this Statement of Special Inspection.
- Review submitted inspection reports.
- Perform inspections as required by the local building code.

Owner's Authorization:

The undersigned owner or the owner's authorized agent assumes the responsibility of ensuring coordination with the special inspection agency during construction to ensure performance of the marked inspections. Further the undersigned owner or owners' authorized agent acknowledges aware that they are responsible for hiring and employing the special inspection agency in order to maintain the independence from the contractor as required by CBC 1703.1.1. The undersigned also states that he/she understands the duties and responsibilities of the special inspector. All fees/costs related to the performance of Special Inspections shall be the responsibility of the owner.

INSTRUCTION TO THE SPECIAL INSPECTION AGENCY

1. Provide interim/daily field reports to the building inspector on site as construction progresses. Daily field reports shall be numbered sequentially for later reference.
2. A copy of all special inspection test laboratory reports shall be sent to the City's Building Official and the RDP in responsible charge.
3. The special inspection agency shall notify the Building Official and the RDP in responsible charge of any conflict of interest between the agency and the Owner/Owner's authorized agent or any other entity involved in this agreement.
4. Upon completion of special inspections and testing work, provide to the City the completed final special inspections report (*Part V attached*), wet stamped and signed by the responsible professional engineer of the special inspection agency – such report shall also be sent to the registered design professional in responsible charge (*designer of record*) for the structure.

PART III – STATEMENT OF SPECIAL INSPECTIONS

Instructions: The registered design professional shall describe the necessary inspections for the project in the inspections required box. The inspection frequency shall be identified as either periodic or continuous, or performed as specified and notated in accordance with the applicable referenced material standard (e.g. AISC 360/341, TMS 402/602) prescribed by code

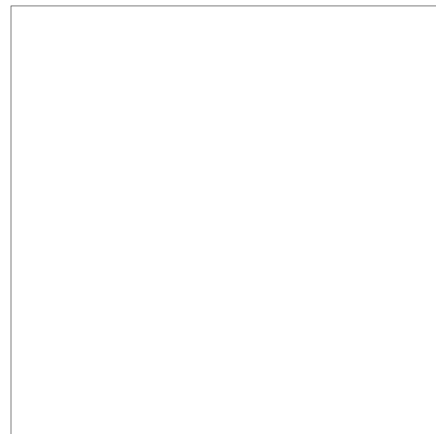

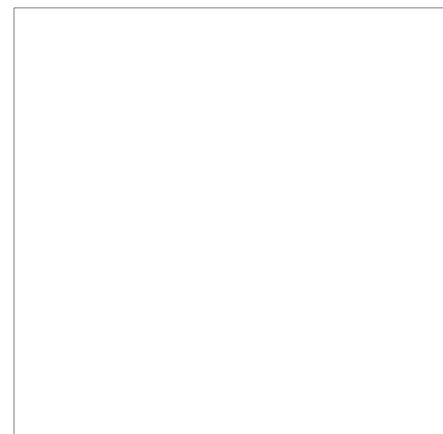
