BUSINESS LICENSE FEE EXEMPTION FOR VETERANS

Section 14B.6 Of Chapter 14 of Article I of the Dixon City Code Ordinance 10-002 exempting any soldier, sailor or marine of the United States who is currently on active duty or has received an honorable discharge or a release from active duty under honorable conditions from such service, and any spouse or widow of any such soldier, sailor or marine.

Qualified exempt veterans must comply with local and state regulations and an annual operating permit will continue to be issued; however, no fee will be required.

To qualify for the exemption, veterans:

- 1. Must be on active duty, honorably discharged or honorably relieved from military, naval or air services.
- 2. Must be a spouse or widow of any such soldier, sailor or marine.
- 3. <u>Must</u> submit to this office current active duty identification or discharge papers. (DD214) or (DD256)
- 4. Must show proof of identification.
