RE: Juneteenth Holiday

On June 16, 2021 President Biden signed a bill passed by the Senate and House to officially recognize Juneteenth as a federal holiday. This is to confirm the agreement reached between the City of Dixon ("City") and Dixon Professional Firefighters Association ("DPFA") representing the Dixon Firefighters unit regarding this new holiday. The City and DPFA shall collectively be referred to as "Parties."

Specifically, the City and DPFA have agreed to the following:

Juneteenth Day will be added as a paid holiday pursuant to Article 11 – Holidays, Section 11.1. The parties recognize that observing Juneteenth is a way to commemorate the end of slavery in the United States.
