RE: Juneteenth Holiday

On June 16, 2021 President Biden signed a bill passed by the Senate and House to officially recognize Juneteenth as a federal holiday. This is to confirm the agreement reached between the City of Dixon ("City") and Dixon Police Officers ("DPOA") representing the Dixon Police Officers unit regarding this new holiday. The City and DPOA shall collectively be referred to as "Parties."

Specifically, the City and DPOA have agreed to the following:

Juneteenth Day will be added as a paid holiday pursuant to Article 8 – Holidays, Section 8.1. The parties recognize that observing Juneteenth is a way to commemorate the end of slavery in the United States.

8.1 Holidays

8.1.1 The following Holidays are recognized by the City:


